Also, present County Clerk David Dowling. Chairman McGregor stated the open meetings laws are posted on the wall for public inspection.

Motion was made by McGregor and seconded by Bartels to approve the agenda. Motion carried with a to 0 vote. Motion was made by Bartels and seconded by Donner to approve the minutes from the last meeting. Motion carried with a 3 to 0 vote.

Road Supt., Carla Schmidt reported she has received the first aid kits for each of the districts to be placed in the machines. Carla then talked about CDL training that may be available in Hartington. Discussion was then held on how the county will handle future training expenses when the need arises.

Monthly fee reports were presented from sheriff and district court and were reviewed by the board. With no further business or agenda items the chairman declared the meeting adjourned.
